

Intellectual Property Certificate Application For Non-JD Students

Akron Law offers non-degree certificate-seeking students the opportunity to specialize in intellectual property law and to receive a certificate denoting successful completion of the requirements. Students must complete 12 required credits and attain an aggregate cumulative 2.0 grade point average.

Before enrolling as a non-JD student, you should discuss your interest first with our IP faculty to determine whether this program is right for you.
